AJ Elkins Releases Debut Album "Full Circle"

WILMINGTON, DE - Indie solo artist AJ Elkins has released his debut album "Full Circle" on September 9, 2022. The record was produced, mixed, and mastered by AJ's brother Frank Darwicki V at Bad Brew Studios in Smyrna, Delaware. Full Circle features 12 original tracks, with quest appearances by Frank and Sami Hunter.



The record features the earmarked singles Don't Adult Good, Through The Lens, Breathe In Breathe Out, and The Long Haul (Strings Version). In addition to producing Full Circle, Frank contributed lead guitar on The Long Haul. Missing Pieces, Watch The World Spin, and Back To You. He also recorded the drums on The Long Haul. Frank and Sami Hunter provided the choir vocals on Breathe In Breathe Out.

Full Circle was approximately nine years in the making, the upcoming single Through The Lens was first penned in 2013. AJ was previously the drummer and co-songwriter of the Delaware-based original rock band

Darkin. Darkin was a featured artist at the inaugural Indie Entertainment Summit in Los Angeles, and extensively performed throughout the mid-Atlantic. The band was featured on 93.7 FM WSTW's Hometown Heroes segment and performed live in studio on 93.5 FM The Beach's Local Produce show.

AJ's previous solo singles received nationwide airplay on college and noncommercial radio. In 2018, Egonomcis received airplay on over two dozen North American stations, while the 2020 version of The Long Haul received considerable airplay on 88.1 FM WRFL in Lexington, KY. The follow-up single Hidden Blessings was also featured on Delaware Public Media's Hometown Heroes segment hosted by Mark Rogers.
